GEOCLUBE AND CINDOR TAKE STEPS TOWARDS AN ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION THROUGH THE EUROPENA PROJECT:

Geoclube and CINDOR have partnered with six European Union partners - Hungary (project managers), Sweden, Romania, Germany and Turkey - in a project of social responsibility and environmental education to raise awareness of the need to preserve the planet, through pedagogical methodologies and the development of new educational resources.

In this context, CINDOR and Geoclube professionals traveled to Hungary in January 28th to 30th for a first meeting between the partners, which allowed the sharing of experiences and pedagogical realities in different countries and teaching systems, as well as methodologies applied during the training, the results obtained and, finally, to define the objectives for the coming months.
